### LENTIL SOUP

Helen Beall

1 C	dried lentils, rinsed	5 C	vegetable or chicken stock or bouillon (more, if needed)
1 tsp	salt	¼ C	olive oil
2 C	chopped onions	3	cloves garlic, chopped
¼ tsp	cayenne (optional)	2	bay leaves
½ C	raw bulghür	¼ C	chopped fresh parsley
2 C	chopped tomatoes (I use canned)	¼ C	tomato paste
pinch	dried rosemary (or to taste)		salt and freshly ground pepper to taste
2 C	spinach, cleaned, stemmed, coarsely chopped		
	fresh parsley, chopped		

Bring lentils to boil in salted stock of water. Reduce heat and simmer, covered for 40 minutes. Heat olive oil in heavy soup pot. Sauté onions until translucent. Add garlic, cayenne, bay leaves and raw bulghür. Stir mixture on medium heat until onions and bulghür are lightly browned. Mix in some parsley and tomatoes. When the tomatoes begin to give up their juice, gently stir in tomato paste.

Pour lentils with liquid into the soup pot. Simmer for 15 minutes. Add rosemary, salt and pepper to taste. If needed, add more stock, water or tomato juice. Remove bay leaves. Just before serving, stir in fresh spinach and let it wilt in the hot soup. Garnish with fresh parsley and serve with crusty bread.

NOTE: This recipe was given to me by my daughter, Connie.

### PAT'S POTATOES

Linda Perry

6	baking potatoes, baked and halved	2	t sp salt
¼	ttsp pepper	4	Tbsp butter
4	Tbsp sour cream	4	Tbsp cottage cheese
1	egg	1	Tbsp chopped onion

Mix salt, pepper, butter, sour cream, cottage cheese, egg and chopped onion with scooped out potato pulp from baked potatoes—retain skins intact. When thoroughly mixed, refill potato skins with mixture. Reheat at 425° for 10 minutes.
